Holotropic Breathwork was pioneered by Stanislav Grof, MD and his late wife Christina Grof. The term holotropic literally translates as moving toward wholeness. The breathwork practice combines accelerated breathing with evocative music in a supported setting. With the eyes closed and lying on a mat, each person uses their own breath and the music in the room to enter an expanded state of consciousness. This state activates the natural inner healing process of the breather s psyche which guides the experience. It has truly been a journey that has taken courage, hope, trust and compassion.
